

THE DEATH PENALTY

“He cheated on his punishment”, said the majority of those interviewed on TV following the suicide death of mass medical murderer, Dr Shipton. Their claim was they were robbed of seeing justice done upon him. He should have been forced to live so he could be known to suffer. But why didn't they demand Shipton be put to death for murdering hundreds of his patients in the UK?
